STUDY ABROAD SCHOLARSHIP

Scholarships for Study Abroad are awarded by the College of Agriculture and Natural Resources. The amount and number of scholarships are variable depending on funds available.

To be eligible for a CANR Study Abroad scholarship, you must:

1. Be a student in the College of Agriculture and Natural Resources (CANR) and officially accepted in a credit-bearing CANR Study Abroad program.
2. Submit an essay detailing how the Study Abroad program will enhance your academic experience in the major. The essay should be attached to the application form and must be submitted by the stated deadline.

Essays must:

- Include your name and the name/location of the Study Abroad program
 - Be typed and no longer than 400 words in length
 - Incorporate the following:
 - Why you want to study abroad and why you chose this particular program
 - How studying abroad will help you meet your academic, professional and personal goals
 - What personal strengths/qualities you possess that will help you be successful abroad
 - Why you need this scholarship and how you will use it
3. Within one month of returning from your program, you must submit at least one photograph taken during your Study Abroad program, as well as a short written statement, up to 400 words, about your experience. This information, including your name and/or photo, may be used for educational, advertising, and promotional purposes.

Students are eligible to receive a CANR Study Abroad scholarship only once during their academic career.

Scholarship funds will be deposited into a student's account after departure on the Study Abroad program.

If a student withdraws from a program, for any reason (voluntary or involuntary), the CANR scholarship will be revoked. If the scholarship is revoked after funds have been disbursed, the student will be billed for the award amount through his/her MSU student account.

Scholarship Application Deadlines

The completed application form and essay must be submitted by the following deadlines:

Winter break 2016, Spring 2017 programs	October 30, 2016
Spring break 2017 programs	January 30, 2017
Summer 2017 and Fall 2017 programs	March 15, 2017

NOTE: If the deadline falls on a weekend, applications are due the following Monday.
