#### What does 4-H Exploration Days cost?

The cost for the 2023 event is \$220, which includes two nights' lodging in a residence hall, meals, learning sessions, an event T-shirt and free-time activities. ### Save the date for Michigan 4-H Day with the Detroit Tigers!


