Our new 4-H year began on September 1, 2019. All 4-H members and leaders are strongly encouraged to enroll online. If you have forgotten your 4-H online login information, please do not make a new profile. Instead, please contact our office and we can reset your password for you. To register for 2019-2020 go to www.mi.4honline.com

The deadline to enroll in 4-H Online and to pay your enrollment fee of \$20 per member (\$60 family, 4 + children) will be March 31, 2020 by 5:00 p.m. There will be no exceptions to this deadline. If your child is not registered and paid for by the deadline, they will not be eligible to participate in 4-H for the current year (including fair, as a 4-H member). Please keep in mind that this deadline does not override your club's deadline. Example: your key leader requires you to pay your enrollment fee and register online by January 1, 2020. You would follow that deadline. We encourage all payments be made with your key leader but you may make a payment in the MSU Extension office. For your convenience, we now can take credit/debit cards or you can mail your payment in.

2020 State Award Applications now available

Michigan 4-H members ages 11 and older have an opportunity to be recognized for the great work they do in 4-H by completing a state award application. A Michigan 4-H State Award is the highest honor bestowed on a Michigan 4-H member and provides an opportunity to receive recognition for their engagement in rich learning experiences that result in outstanding knowledge and life-skill development.

State award applications are divided into four categories: Mark of Excellence essay contest (11-12 years old), junior state award (13-15 years old), senior state award (16-19 years old) and group awards (13-19 years old). The application process and selection is determined by the age of the 4-H member. Final candidates for the junior, senior and group level awards in each project area will be selected to participate in the State Awards program during 4-H Exploration Days in June, where final selection and announcement of winners will take place.

MSU Extension to launch new portal for volunteers in 2020

In early 2020, MSU Extension will launch Volunteer Central, a statewide volunteer management database and screening system. Volunteers are the core of many MSU Extension programs and the most essential partners MSU Extension has. In the new system, volunteers will enjoy improved features including easy-to-read dashboards and a one-stop application process, among other advantages.

A unique feature of Volunteer Central is that each volunteer will have their own unique online account and profile. Unlike 4-H Online, family profiles will not be permitted. This is necessary to protect the confidentiality of each volunteer and the integrity of data in the system. In preparation for the launch of Volunteer Central, those who currently share an email address with another 4-H volunteer should make plans to create a separate email address for each shared user. Once you have created a new email address, please either:

- 1. Log in to 4-HOnline and add the newly created email address to the volunteer with whom it should be associated; or
- 2. Contact your local 4-H program coordinator and share the newly created email address and the volunteer with whom the account should be associated.

The email addresses in 4-H Online and shared with 4-H program coordinators will be used to create access accounts for current volunteers in Volunteer Central. In the coming weeks, look for additional information about Volunteer Central and when current volunteers will have access to the system. In the meantime, please contact your local 4-H program coordinator with any questions or concerns.

Tractor Operator Program (TOP)
