- Must either possess Interim Occupational Certificate (IOC) or Occupational Education Certificate (OEC) in Applied Horticulture and Horticulture Operations or Agriculture Science and Natural Resources; or willingness to obtain.
- Must meet Federal Highly Qualified Teacher requirements.
- No physical or mental restrictions that would with reasonable accommodations prevent performance of the essential job functions and responsibilities required for the position or that would prevent regular attendance.
- Record of regular attendance.
- Must submit to and pay costs for a Criminal History Background Check.
