

MONTHLY FEED RECORD AND EXPENSE

You will need to keep track of how much your animal eats to have an accurate record. This is easiest to do when feeding concentrates and square bales of hay because you can weigh out the feed. As your animal grows, the amount of feed increases, and the feed costs also increase. Filling in the feed table will make your job easier. For animals eating large round bales or pasture, you may need to get help from your leader. Waiting until the last minute to make these calculations will cause stress for you, your parent, and your leader.
