- Peer review services for proposal feedback prior to submission.

Discretionary Funding Initiative (DFI):

- Competitive source of bridge funds for additional studies in support of previously submitted and nearly fundable federal proposals
- Up to \$50,000 per award, college and departmental contributions required
- DFI submissions must be approved by department and college
- Copies of previous proposal, reviews, and narrative on how plan to address reviews required
