

### Citizenship Washington Focus: Travel to DC with Michigan 4-H!

Learning about our nation's history empowers today's youth to forge a brighter future. What better place to do that than Washington, DC! Teens, ages 14-19, are invited to join the Michigan 4-H delegation from June 24<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup>, 2023 for the week-long trip. Experience Washington, DC like never before or ever again. With a tour guide providing background information for many monuments and programs that teach life skills such as civil discourse and critical thinking, youth will be able to use their voice and expand their horizons. Cost is \$2000 and 7 meals enroute.

The Michigan 4-H Delegation will visit the Flight 93 National Memorial in Somerset County, Pennsylvania and then overnights in Gettysburg to tour the battlefields (June 24-25) before CWF (June 25-30). These side trips provide youth with a historical background to our government.

### **Opportunity to teach at 4-H Exploration Days 2023**


