Sedeveria	Jet Beads	23-Mar	29-May	4	7/9/18: Color does not pop, still small. 10/1/18: Some gaps in container, probably because of the upright habit.
Sedeveria	Sorrento	23-Mar	29-May	5	7/9/18: Getting leggy. 10/1/18: Full container. Nice color, lots of branching and flowering. Gorgeous!
Sedum adolphii	Firestorm	23-Mar	29-May	3	7/9/18: Slightly spiker leaves and more color on edges than S. nussbaumerianum. Not full yet. 10/1/18: Lots of gaps in container and leggy plants. Not uniform in habit, but interesting orange/yellow leaf color.
Sedum carnicolor		16-Mar	29-May	4	7/9/18: Leggy, could use some branching, plants falling over under own weight. 10/1/18: Gaps in container and not uniform. Lovely orange colored leaf tips though.
Sedum clavatum	Aurora Blue	16-Mar	29-May	4	7/9/18: Leggy, falling over. 10/1/18: Gaps along edges, but otherwise completely filled in. Lots of offsets.
