



Certificate Programs at the Institute for Food Laws and Regulations

Students earn a certificate upon successful completion of 12 credits from applicable online courses through IFLR. Students may earn both certificates below if desired. One course (three credits) may be applied toward both certificates. Therefore, it is possible for students to earn both certificates after completing 21 relevant credits (usually seven courses).

The courses below are all currently offered for three credits each. IFLR has offered a "Certificate in International Food Law" since 1998 and introduced the "Certificate in United States Food Law" in 2017.
