- Founded in 1998 by Dr. P. Vincent Hegarty.
- IFLR has awarded over 325 certificates since the first certificate was awarded in 2002.
- 30 industry experts offer lectures in our classes (plus a number of Emeriti offering their expertise and course material).
- Thirteen online courses offered in food laws and regulations.
- Over 3,300 students to date.
- Average of 18 students per class.
- Average of 125 students enrolled in any given fall or spring semester (based on last 5 years).






