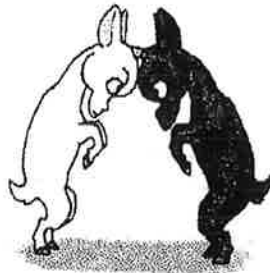
## Objectives of the 4-H Cloverbud Goat Project

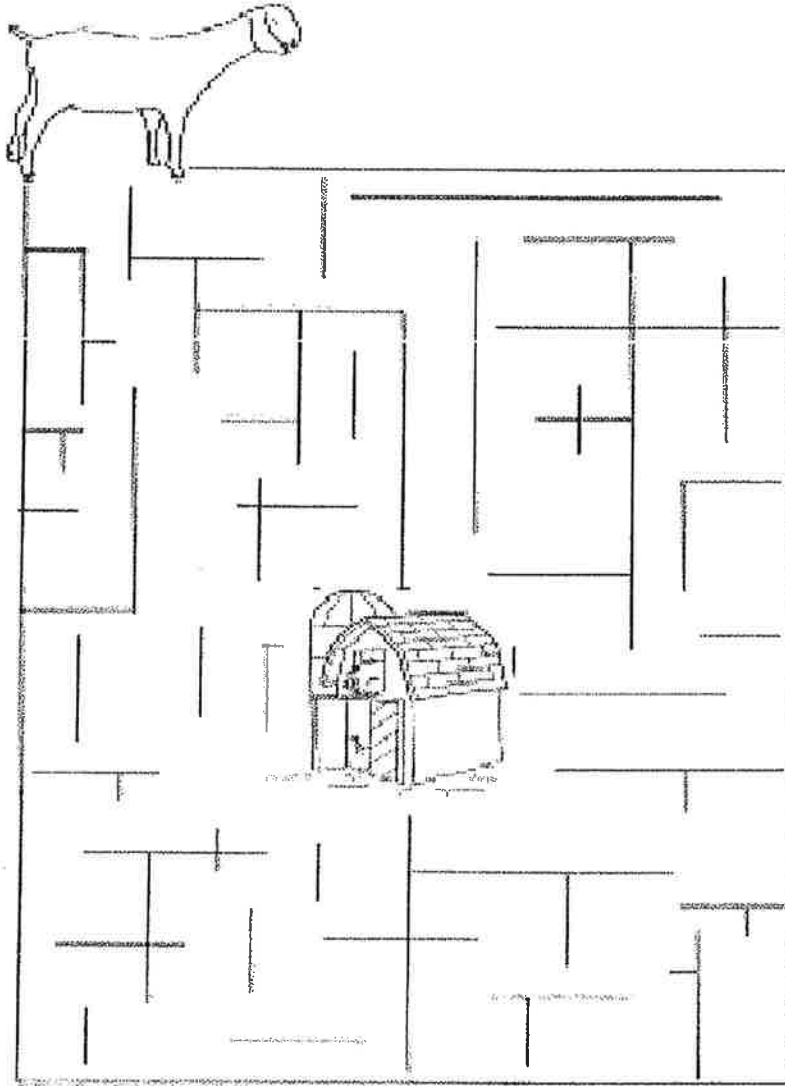
