## <u>Intermediate 4-H Royal Ambassador Team</u> <u>Criteria</u>

- Age: 12-14 by January 1st of the current year.
- Enrolled in an Isabella County 4-H club for two (2) or more years, which may include cloverbud years.
- Complete the Intermediate 4-H Royal Ambassador Packet.
- Two (2) Letters of Recommendation that must be completed by a current Isabella County 4-H Leader and another letter written by an adult outside of 4-H. It can be a teacher, pastor, coach etc. both letters cannot not be a relative.
- Complete a typed 2-page Essay (double spaced,times new roman, 12 pt font) about your experience as a 4-H Member of Isabella County, how you would recruit young kids to join the 4-H community, what ways you could make a difference for the Isabella County Fair, what community services that you would recommend the court to be involved in, and why would you like to be Isabella County Junior Royal Ambassador?
- Turn in a completed hand-written Application Form, two (2) letters of Recommendation, a Personal Information Sheet, and an Essay to the 4-H Extension Office by Friday, May 3rd, 2024.
- Prepare a visual aid depicting your 4-H involvement, which you will share with the evaluating Panel Interview on Thursday, June 6th from 5-7 pm or Sunday, June 9th from 1-5 pm at Maranatha Baptist Church. (It can be 4-H craft related such as Tri Fold, PowerPoint, Quilt, Bird House, WoodWork Project, Game Board, or anything you can wow the judges with.) BE CREATIVE!

## Helpful Hints and Information

- 1. Complete the entire 4-H Ambassador Application packet in your handwriting; thoroughly answer all questions listed and read each item carefully.
- 2. A 4-H leader in Isabella County should complete the Leader Recommendation Form and the second Recommendation form to be completed by an adult non-4-H(Teacher,Pastor,Coach ect). A relative cannot fill out both of these recommendations. All forms and essays should be turned in to the 4-H Extension office by 4:00 pm, Friday May 3rd, 2024. Make sure to ask a leader and a non-4-H leader soon so they have enough time to complete it – don't wait until three or four days before the packet is due – there won't be enough time to complete it.
- 3. When working on your Essay, ensure you meet all the requirements. The Essay needs to be 1-2 pages, double-spaced, and in Times New Roman, 12 font, answering the questions on pages 2 and 3(1. Your experience as a 4-H Member, 2. How would you get kids to join the 4-H Program? 3. What differences can you make for the Isabella County Fair? 4. Why would you like to be Isabella County Junior Royal Ambassador?) Ensure you proofread your work and submit your Essay with the application Packet when turning it into the 4-H Extension office.
- 4. Develop a visual aid that shows what 4-H means to you. Bring the visual aid to your interview on June 6th or June 7th, 2024. It may include pictures/brochures from 4-H events you have attended, accomplishments at the fair, or your future 4-H plans. The display should be organized, clean, creative, and positive. You can do a PowerPoint, tri-fold, scrapbook, quilt, or come up with something to show the judges you and your 4-H experience. Show your style and take pride in it.
- 5. Participating in a personal interview. Dress nicely and neatly; we suggest you not wear jeans, shorts, t-shirts, tank tops, or flip-flops. When you step into the room to meet with the judges, you want to make a very positive first impression -- dress for success! You will have approximately ten minutes (which may increase depending on the number of applicants) in which to describe/discuss your visual aid, and the judges will ask you some questions. Practice with someone ahead of time and be yourself. Let the judges get to know you, and show them why you would be a GREAT 4-H Ambassador!
- 6. The most important thing is to have FUN!

  - b. Assist at the Still Exhibit Auction, Small Animal Auction, Large Animal Auction, and Awards Program – these events are required during fair week.
  - c. The team *may* attend one of the grandstand events, to be determined by the program coordinators.
  - d. Participate in Goat Milking, Dairy Hand Milking, Baby Calf Parade, and Pedal Pullers Competition.
  - e. Be present at small and large animal showmanship events to lead pledges and f. Pass out awards.

  - a. Attending 4-H Banquets.
