



SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

The Center for Regional Food Systems at Michigan State University is pleased to offer a limited number* of scholarships to the 2018 Michigan Good Food Summit on October 22, 2018 at the Kellogg Hotel and Conference Center on the campus of Michigan State University. Scholarships are intended to support attendees who would not otherwise be able to take part in the Summit. Any Michigan resident may apply. All applicants who demonstrate an interest in the Summit and the importance of receiving assistance will be entered into a lottery for the available scholarships. Each scholarship includes full Summit registration, including meals provided at the Summit. Hotel accommodations and travel expenses* are the responsibility of the scholarship recipient.

** <u>Do not register for the Summit at this time.</u> Applicants will be notified of their scholarship status on or before September 28th.

- Those applicants not awarded scholarships will still be able to register for the Summit at the regular rates.

* Note: The Michigan Good Food Summit is offering complimentary same-day bus transportation to and from the October 22, 2018 Summit from the following cities: (1) Ann Arbor/Ypsilanti, (2) Battle Creek/Kalamazoo, (3) Detroit, (4) Flint, (5) Grand Rapids/Muskegon. Due to cost considerations, we will need 25 people registered from each city in order to provide the bus. Registrants will be notified in October if a particular bus service needs to be cancelled. Buses will pick up people at the designated location sometime between 6:00 and 7:00 a.m., depending on the distance to East Lansing, and drop them off at the Kellogg Center in time for breakfast and registration. Buses will depart the Kellogg Center in East Lansing within 15 minutes of the end of the Summit and return to the designated location in each city. Information on the designated locations and pick up times will be provided on the registration system approximately a month prior to the Summit and will be e-mailed to all registrants the week prior to the Summit.
