Remaining Training option \$12.00 **Web based training** Go to <u>https://yqcaprogram.org</u> and log in using the account you created last year, if you are new to YQCA you will need to create an account (see help doc below).

After logging in, you will need to select the correct YQCA class depending on age.

Youth can complete the course online each module takes 15-20 minutes with there is a total of five (5) modules.






