Titled the "Urban and Regional Planning Practicum," this course integrates a student's educational training in planning with the real world challenges of developing and preparing a professional planning project with selected community partners. Practicum is considered a student-led, faculty-guided learning experience and seeks to bridge the transition from classroom learning to professional practice for emerging planning professionals.

We are currently soliciting planning studies from potential community partners for students to work on during their final semester beginning in January. If you are interested in submitting a proposal for practicum, please complete the attached two-page request form and send it to salmistu@msu.edu by <u>November 20<sup>th</sup></u>. While a number of factors go into selecting appropriate practicum sites by the faculty, priority is given to communities that do not have resources to hire professional consultants. However, projects will be chosen based on quality, variety, and appropriateness for the class.

If your project is selected for Practicum, we require every project have a community contact that is familiar with the project in detail, and interested in the planning process and the outcomes of the course. Clients are expected to play an integral role in the development of the scope of work with the student team, make themselves available to the students on an as-needed basis, provide timely and constructive criticism and feedback on draft reports, and attend the final presentation by the students.

As the number of projects we are able to accept depends on the number of students registered for the course, we are unable to guarantee project acceptance until the beginning of the semester in January. We will, however, make preliminary selections by December 15.
