Ink on Glass

Project Guidelines



- 1. Exhibit must be <u>framed</u> and have a <u>hanging wire</u> securely attached to the back of the frame. Exhibits that do not meet these requirements will automatically receive one full A, B, C grade <u>lower</u> at project evaluation at fair.
- 2. Exhibitors 8 11 years of age by January 1 <u>must</u> use regular "clear" glass. Non-glare glass not allowed at this age level.
- 3. Exhibitors 12 years of age and older by January 1 <u>may</u>, if desired, experiment with other types of glass (i.e. non-glare, colored, textured, etc.).
- 4. Any type of black/red or white permanent ink may be used as the "ink" medium.

 No other colored inks.
- 5. Any type of material may be used, if desired, as a "background" to "highlight" the drawing (i.e. paint, fabric, colored paper, colored tissue paper, wallpaper, etc. may be <u>placed behind the glass</u>).
- 6. Exhibit must be <u>signed and dated</u> with at least the year of completion on the glass by the exhibitor.
