- 1. A member any exhibit in only one (1) class.
- 2. No more than two (2) pictures of a set to be entered.
- 3. Those projects that need it must be <u>CLEAN, DRY, AND</u> <u>IRONED.</u>

<u>Classes</u>

- Articles painted on pellon or cotton material using outline and fill-in (or simple blending of colors). Pre-shaded pictures may be used here but may not be used if a member is past third year in this project.
- 2. Best-of-Show in class 1.
- 3. Shading of colors and more difficult designs than Class 1.
- 4. Best-of-Show in Class 3.
- 5. <u>One</u> item on velveteen or suede cloth using regular tip.
- 6. Best-of-Show in Class 5.
- 7. Painting on any surface including velveteen, leather, suede, glass, etc., with brush, open-tip, Q-tips or any other method other than regular tip.
- 8. Best-of-Show in Class 7.
- 9. Original designs on pellon, cotton, velveteen, etc.
- 10. Best-of-Show in Class 9.
