St. Joseph County 4-H Jewelry Making Project Guidelines



- Exhibitors may exhibit in only one class.
- No more than three items should be exhibited.
- Jewelry must be exhibited on a card in a plastic bag.
- Age of exhibitor and complexity of project will be considered during judging.

<u>Classes</u>

- 1. First Year Simple jewelry setting/design. Article(s) made such as necklaces, pins, bracelets, brooches, jeweled pencil cases, etc.
- 2. Best Exhibit in Class 1.
- 3. Second Year Jewelry made and/or shaped by exhibitor.
- 4. Best Exhibit in Class 3.
- 5. Advanced Same as second year, but with emphasis on advanced work.
- 6. Best Exhibit in Class 5.
- 7. Best-of-Show in Classes 2, 4, and 6.
- 8. Jewelry made from rocks or minerals.
- 9. Best-of-Show in Class 8.
