## Wardrobe Personalization

## **Project Guidelines and Exhibit Requirements**

Purpose of Project: To encourage originality and creativity through development and use of variety of wardrobe personalization techniques.

- 1. "Personalization" work must be done by the member.
- 2. Garments, shoes and/or accessories selected for personality may either be purchased or handmade.
- 3. Suggested items include:
  - Any article of clothing (i.e. shirt, T-shirt, sweatshirt, sweater, jacket, skirt, slacks, etc.)
  - Tote/duffel bag or purse
  - Scarf
  - Belt
  - Hat
  - Shoes
  - Other
- 4. Personalization exhibit may be either a single item or an "ensemble" (grouping of garments and/or accessories intended to be worn together).
- 5. Project personalization technique(s) should be based on member's age and ability level. Member should work on developing new personalization skills with each successive year in the project.
- 6. Personalization techniques that may be used alone or in combination include
  - Applique
  - Beading
  - Counted cross-stich
  - Duplicate stitch (floss stitch over knitting/crocheting)
  - Embroidery (liquid, floss, crewel)
  - Knitting/crocheting (i.e. knit-in or crocheted-in yoke)
  - Needlepoint
  - Needlepunch (i.e. "pretty punch")
  - Painting
  - Quilting
  - "sew-ons" (i.e. addition of collar, cuffs, etc.)
  - Silk screening
  - Stenciling
  - Tie-dyeing
  - "wonder-under" (cut and press "quickie" applique)
  - Other
