These awards are designed to recognize Lapeer County 4-H Leaders who have shown outstanding involvement and support for the Lapeer County 4-H program. Nominees should have made a wide range of contributions to 4-H and serve as a positive influence on youth members and other 4-H volunteers, strive to promote and expand 4-H.



- Meritorious Service Award is awarded a Lapeer County 4-H Leader who has served between one and five years as a 4-H Leader.
- Outstanding Lifetime Leader Award is awarded to a Lapeer county 4-H Leader who has served six or more years as a 4-H leader.

Recipients will be recognized at the awards ceremony at Spring Achievement.

ELIGIBILITY:

The nominee must be enrolled as a 4-H leader in the Lapeer County 4-H program.

A leader may only receive each award once.

There are no limitations on who can nominate a leader for this award.

Should have completed/attended one of the following:

- Fair Superintendent
- Participation in county committee (4-H Council, Spring Achievement, Livestock, Spring Auction, Camp, etc)
- Participation in Exploration Days, Kettunen Center Training(s), State or Regional 4-H Events, etc.

Nominations are due to the Lapeer County MSU Extension Office by the first Monday in November.

Please provide nomination letter(s) that includes specific examples of this leader's outstanding contributions to the Lapeer County 4-H program during their years of service. Please provide as much detail as possible, including time commitment, number of youth or adults reached, how efforts affect visibility/expansion of 4-H, etc. You may include additional pages and supporting documentation up to three one sided pages.

Nomination letters should address the some following selection criteria:

- Positive impact the nominee has had on 4-H and on 4-H youth
- Nominee's ability to work with young people on projects and activities in a way that promotes decision-making, problem-solving, meeting challenges, mastery and youth/adult partnerships
- Nominee's innovative approaches to engaging youth and to performing volunteer service
- How nominee models character and professional behavior when interacting with participants, families, and community partners
- Increased funding/resources/new initiatives generated by nominee
- Recruitment of additional 4-H volunteers.
