## WHO SHOULD ATTEND:

Hispanic/Latino growers and farm workers interested in obtaining their Michigan Private Pesticide Applicator license. This training program will be in Spanish.

## DESCRIPTION:

This training session will start with a review session of major topics related to Integrated Pest Management (IPM), Worker Protection Standards (WPS) and current pesticide application legislation. Those topics are part of the “**Manual Básico de Entrenamiento para Aplicadores de Pesticidas E-3008-SPKITP**”.

## Additional Event Information

This training session is part of a large educational program developed to provide growers and farm workers with knowledge and tools to manage Production Risks issues. Insects and diseases are one of the major Production Risks in fruit and greenhouse production systems. Successful management of those risks requires knowledge and a basic understanding of Integrated Pest Management, and Federal and State legislations regulating registration, labeling, use of pesticides used, etc. In addition, understand the impact of the use of pesticides on humans, animals, and the environment in which pest management is implemented.
