The 2018-2019 4-H year is here—Enroll in 4-H today! Volunteers and youth can enroll at home or use our 4-H volunteer computer at the MSU Extension office. The \$20 4-H enrollment fee (\$60 family fee for 3+ children in the same family) or participation fee scholarship form can NOT be paid or completed online, you must come into our office, drop it in our secure mailbox located outside of our main entrance, or mail us your participation fee/waiver form. Youth are NOT enrolled in 4-H until their participation fee/scholarship is turned into the Alpena MSU Extension office and they have completed their 4-H Online enrollment. Don't miss the March 1, 2019 deadline in order to be eligible to market livestock projects at this year's fair.

<u>Michigan Certi-</u> <u>fied Pullorum</u> <u>Testers Work-</u> <u>shop</u>

Registration for the <u>2019</u> <u>Michigan Certified Pullorum</u> <u>Testers Workshop</u> that will be held on March 5th at the MSU Pavilion is now open.

Pullorum Disease (Salmonella pullorum-typhoid), which is caused by the bacteria Salmonella, is one of the most important poultry diseases. Pullorum Disease has been eradicated in U.S. commercial poultry, and it is critical to maintain this disease-free status by monitoring the Pullorum status in commercial, backyard and exhibition poultry.

In order for youth and adults to exhibit poultry at a show, poultry must be either certified pullorum-typhoid free through the National Poultry Improvement Plan (NPIP) or test negative for Pullorum within 90 days of exhibition.

This training will provide adults, aged <u>18 and older</u> the ability to perform the certified pullorum tests. The certification training fee is \$35.

Michigan 4-H Participant Age Policy Change

Beginning September 1, 2018, the Michigan 4-H Participant Age Policy changed to reflect lowering our competitive age from 9 to 8 years old. The new age for competitive 4-H members is 8 to 19 years old, continuing to use January 1 of the program year (September 1 – August 31) as the date of calculation. The 4-H Cloverbud experience will remain available to youth ages 5–7. Alpena County 4-H has aligned their market animal sale and other contest rules with the Michigan 4-H participant age policy change.
