



THE RED SPOT IS THE TARGET.

PENETRATING CAPTIVE BOLT GUN:

Animal movement prior to the shot must be controlled with a gate, halter or snare (swine).

The penetrating captive bolt gun must be **placed on and perpendicular to the skull.**

.025 Red Cartridges are effective.



Confirmation of insensibility within 30 seconds:

1. Lack of corneal reflex
2. Inability to right itself or floppy head
3. Lack of pain response

Confirmation of death within 3 minutes:

1. Lack of corneal reflex
2. Lack of respiration
3. Lack of heartbeat
4. Lack of vocalization

If animal is not rendered insensible, use a second shot with a firearm or captive bolt gun.
