Antrim County 4-H Continuing Education Scholarship Requirements

Continuing Education Scholarship – One time only, up to (2) \$500.00 one-time scholarships available to graduating seniors.

Criteria to receive this scholarship include:

- 1. MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS
 - A. The 4-H member must be currently active in 4-H in Antrim County.
 - B. The 4-H member must have been active for at least <u>3 years</u> and have successfully completed projects during that time.
 - C. Amount of involvement the member has had in other areas of 4-H and their community.
 - D. The 4-H member will have successfully completed their high school education and received a diploma.
 - E. The 4-H member will be continuing their education beyond high school at a college or vocational school.

2. APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- A. Write 750 1000 WORD essay describing your involvement in 4-H and how it has impacted your life.
- B. Provide a letter of recommendation.
- C. If you fail to attend a higher education course, the scholarship is forfeited, and repayment is mandatory.
