


BEEF QUALITY ASSURANCE -IN-PERSON TRAINING & RECERTIFICATION-

Cattle producers who obtained Beef Quality Assurance (BQA) certification ahead of the 2019 packer requirement are now due for recertification. If you certification was obtained more than 3 years ago, it has expired. To help producers renew their BQA certification and to ensure Michigan cattle can be marketed for full value, the Michigan Beef Industry Commission, in partnership with the MSU Extension Beef Team will be coordinating inperson BQA Training and Recertification classes. These classes are for those needing 1st time BQA Certification or those needing Recertification. On-site testing will be included.
