Category: “Council/Committee Member of the Year” Award

1. A maximum of one award per category will be given. Depending on the quantity and quality of nominations received, there may be years where no award at all is given, or where only one category is recognized.
2. The purpose of this award is to recognize a registered Benzie County 4-H volunteer who has done one of the following, for example:
 - Achieved an extraordinary goal.
 - Collected significant donations.
 - Introduced a new program or idea.
 - Helped a building project or improvement become a reality.
 - Provided a valuable service.
 - Supported 4-H’s relationship with an impact on the community in a unique way.
 - Given many years of consistent service, with particularly outstanding highlights.
3. Those who receive an award in a particular category are not eligible to receive in that category again for five years. First consideration will be given to a nominee who has never before received that award.
4. Those eligible to nominate are any registered member or volunteer of Benzie County 4-H.
5. The actual nomination form is on the back. You may duplicate this form or request additional copies from the Extension office.
6. There is no limit to the number of nominations that any one person may submit. Nomination must be received by August 31.
