

YOUTH AWARDS

PROJECT WORK

Must be minimum 4-H age of 12 during past program year Nomination is dependent upon work in a specific project area.

Member must have completed at least three years in that specific project, and be currently enrolled in it, and have not received that medal before. Maximum of 2 medals per project given yearly.

CITIZENSHIP

Must be minimum 4-H age of 14 during past program year.

Intended to honor a member involved in community service work.

Nominee should have been active in service projects for 4-H and other organizations. This award also encourages awareness of civic and governmental workings at the local, state, and national level. One medal given yearly.

LEADERSHIP

Must be minimum 4-H age of 14 during past program year.

Intended to recognize a member who exhibits "leader" behavior. (Good attitude, responsible, and dependable). Nominee should have held office in their club, and participated in or held office in committees or councils. One medal given yearly.

ACHIEVEMENT

Must be minimum 4-H age of 14 during past program year.

Intended to honor a member who has participated in a variety of project areas and 4-H activities both in and outside their county.

Nominee should also have been active in countywide and statewide 4-H events, especially those dealing with project area that member has been involved in for a significant amount of time. One medal given yearly.

1. Any youth member of Manistee or Benzie County 4-H is eligible for the awards listed above.

2. Any registered 4-H leader/member/council/committee member in this county may nominate any member, regardless of club, for these five categories. Members may vote for themselves, but their leaders will be contacted to verify that they have completed the work described and in a manner deserving of the award.

3. Member may only win once in any given category/project in their 4-H career. The 4-H Advisory Council will review nominations, and first consideration will be given to those members who have never received any award, and to those members who are near the end of their 4-H career.

4. Regarding disputes of awards given or not given: all original nomination forms will be held for 7 business days following the awards presentation at the Buyer Banquet. Request for dispute/discussion with 4-H Advisory Council must be made in writing within that period. The matter will be discussed at the next regularly scheduled Advisory Council meeting in October or November.

5. The 4-H Advisory Council will disqualify any nomination form in which all questions have not been answered in full. There is no limit to the number of nominations that any one person may submit. Nominations must be received by August 31.
