

- Attend Leaders Council events.



Berrien County 4-H Foundation

The Berrien County 4-H Foundation is a non-profit corporation created to provide income to finance 4-H youth programs throughout Berrien County. The 4-H Foundation assets are overseen by a volunteer Board of Directors and Advisors who represent a cross-section of people with diverse backgrounds and expertise. Every donation is placed into an investment trust fund. The principle is not touched. Income earned from the trust fund is applied to educational youth programming. Your gift helps youth throughout Berrien County.

Why does the Berrien County 4-H Foundation need my help?

Federal, state, and county resources contribute to the 4-H program, as do the Berrien County 4-H Leaders Council, 4-H Club leaders and parents. These combined contributions fall short of what is needed to adequately support youth.

What benefit will I receive from my donation?

Besides the wonderful feeling of helping 4-H youth to succeed, there may be tax incentives for individuals and businesses.

How do I make my donation?

4-H Equine Educational Activity Scholarship

The Berrien County 4-H Horse Leaders Association would like to present a scholarship opportunity. The scholarship was created to encourage active participation in the Berrien County 4-H Equine Project. Horse ownership and or equine related major/minor is not required for eligibility. Scholarship is awarded to at least two individuals for a minimum of \$500.00.

- Applicants must be a high school graduate and have been a member of the Berrien County 4-H Horse & Pony Project for a minimum of two years.
- Applicant must have completed their first year of college or trade school.
- Applicant may apply and be awarded the scholarship up to 3 times provided they have not reached their 21st birthday by January 1 of the application year. The scholarship will not apply for graduate school.

Applications are due by July 15, 2023, to the Berrien County MSU Extension Office.

4-H Alumni & Cerny Memorial Scholarship

The Berrien County 4-H Leaders Association, Inc. announces two scholarship opportunities – the Alumni Scholarship and the Joseph Cerny & Evelyn Cerny Memorial Scholarship. The Berrien County 4-H Leaders Association, Inc. annually awards one or more scholarships, for a minimum of \$700.00 each. The Joseph Cerny & Evelyn Cerny Memorial Scholarship is also awarded annually for a minimum amount of \$700.00 and is offered independently of the Alumni Scholarship.

Although both scholarships are now awarded to one recipient in the same year, an eligible applicant can be awarded the Cerny Memorial scholarship one year and the Alumni scholarship another year. - **Michigan 4-H RULES APPLY.** This includes 4-H Cloverbud Horse and Pony Rules for youth ages 5 – 7 years. Cloverbud classes will be noncompetitive and will NOT be placed, instead they will each receive a participation award.
- Proof of Negative Coggins MUST be presented at entry office.
- Stall Cards must be displayed at stalls in use. Stall Cards are provided upon payment.
