What is BEES?

BEES is an 8 week parent support program

Delivered in face to face and online formats

For parents and caregivers of children 0-3

Supports social and emotional development

Strengthens parent-child relationships

Supports parents learning how their own experiences impact parenting

Program Impacts

Preliminary results suggest


Increases in:

Knowledge about parenting
Positive attitudes about young children's emotions
Emotionally supportive parenting

The rejection of children's negative emotions
Stress related to parenting particularly for parents

- with more depressive symptoms and
- those whose perceive their children have more challenging temperaments

BEES for Early Childhood Professionals

- A new 8-week series for early childhood professionals provides the same BEES course information to educators and other professionals working with young children. The course is offered both face to face and online. Participants receive certificates for training hours upon completion. Over 120 participants in 31 counties have participated in the pilot course.

BEES Online

- BEES for Parents and BEES for Professionals are both offered in a self-paced online format through MSU's Desire2Learn system. Participants have access to the same content as the face to face course, delivered weekly over eight-weeks. There is a guided chat forum for participant support and interaction.

BEES Curriculum

- BEES was developed through a partnership between MSU Extension's Children & Youth Institute and the Department of Human Development and Family Studies and funded by a USDA/NIFA Children Youth and Families at Risk grant.
