The PRAC is a little over 100 days old

Our mandate in the CARES Act is broad:

- Conduct independent investigations, audits, and reviews relating to covered funds or the Coronavirus response;
- Collaborate on audits and reviews relating to covered funds with any Inspector General of an agency; and
- Provide support to relevant agency Inspectors General in conducting investigations, audits, and reviews relating to the covered funds and Coronavirus response.

PRAC Overview

Our initial focus has been on developing a state-of-the-art website to achieve our Transparency mission; we plan to award a contract later this week for a vendor to build the website

Our vision is:

- To be a force multiplier for the oversight community as a whole
- Establish a leading-edge, data-driven analytics capability to enhance oversight
- Develop innovative forums to engage the public, academia and both ensure transparency of covered funds and enhance oversight of those funds

To date, some of our key accomplishments:

- Developed and launched pandemic.oversight.gov
- Held a virtual listening session with over a dozen witnesses
- Recruited PRAC senior staff members
- Issued Top Management Challenges report
- Began weekly coordination meetings with OMB to discuss data challenges and overcome barriers
- Developed mechanisms to seamlessly coordinate oversight work across the federal, state and local government
