

- help you understand your project's financial outcome,
- improve your management practices,
- give you a record of your project activities, and
- help you plan future projects.

This record for beginner animal projects is a required part of your project and entry into the Emmet-Charlevoix County 4-H Market Livestock shows and sale. You need to submit one record book for each of the market livestock projects you participate in. The record book needs to be completed by the exhibitor.
