Class size max of 8 youth with one instructor and one beach aide

LEVEL 5 & UP - TRIANGLE SWIM OPTION: FRIDAY'S 10:00-12:00PM *this option is in addition to M/W or T/Th classes, if needed*

Levels 5 & up: require 5 miles of triangles to be eligible for the lake swim

INTSTRUCTIONS



1. Select your child's swim level
2. Select M/W or T/Th classes during the week
3. Select A.M. or P.M. time slot option - you cannot pick a specific class time

Exact class times will be determined after registration closes
