- Assemble book in the following order (current year first):
 - 1. Title Page (this page)
 - 2. Project Information Page
 - 3. Show us your project!
 - 4. I know 4-H and Reviewer's Comments
- The 4-H Cloverbud program is an experiential, non-competitive program for youth 4-H age 5 to 7.
- Must be submitted to the MSU Extension Building for review by 12:00pm (noon) on Tuesday of Fair week.
- Awards will be presented during the 4-H Fall Awards Ceremony to all Cloverbuds participating in the record book program.
- Note: Each year keep the pages from this record book in a binder as this is a progressive project record book and should illustrate the knowledge you have gained oved the years in your project area. Record Books can be picked up from the MSU Extension Office after reviewing takes place.
- Please write clearly using blue or black ink OR fill out record book using a computer.
- Youth can add additional pages and or information to this record as they see fit.
