- 7. Willing to put campers needs first before their own needs and help and encourage campers to be a part of the program.
- 8. Understanding that the same rules apply for all campers
- 9. Efficient, capable, prompt, and cheerful.
- 10. Responsible and makes decisions within one's ability.
