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Michigan Indian Leadership Program (MILP)

What is MILP?

MILP is a week-long residential experience where Native American youth can explore both traditional culture and college life! Academic workshops, cultural activities, and social events are all facilitated and supervised by MSU <u>Native</u> faculty, staff, and current undergraduate students! The MILP youth retreat is the perfect place for Native young people to learn about college! MILP 2017 will take place from July 9-14, 2017. Participants must commit to the entire time. Arriving a day late or leaving a day early is not an option. You will stay in the dorms, eat in the cafeteria and do lots of walking.

Who Participates in the MILP?

The program is open to Native American students who will be entering the 8th-12th grades in the fall of 2017. The program is also open to any student in the appropriate grade with a strong interest and involvement in Native American culture and community. Space is limited to 30 applicants who have completed the application process using the application check list provided in this application (incomplete applications will not be considered) AND have completed and returned all the follow-up paperwork including forms such as health information, emergency treatment authorization, various permissions slips (varies year to year depending on activities scheduled), and whatever else may be included in the follow up paperwork. Application deadline is April 28, 2017. Letters of acceptance or denial into the program will be sent out by June 1, 2017. Past participants will be considered for acceptance if the program does not fill will new participants and based on past behavior and participation during the program.

How much does it cost?

There is no cost to participate in MILP 2017. However, participants are responsible for their own transportation to and from MSU located in East Lansing, Michigan.
