Provided: Instructions, Egg Carton, Soil, Labels, seeds

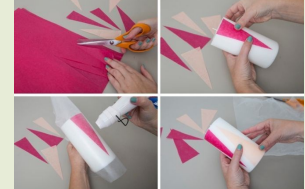
You provide: water, sunlight and loving attention
