How to Register for an Event in the 4-H Online System

Clubs with a participation fee are *Events* in the 4-H Online system. In order to register for a 4-H Event:

1. Youth need to be current 4-H members. Enroll in 4-H at <u>https://v2.4honline.com</u>. Previous members need only to *Renew* their enrollment.

2. Youth need to be registered for the 4-H Event of their choice at https://v2.4honline.com.

3. Payment needs to be completed:

Credit card payment is preferred, and can be completed when registering for the Event. Upon registration, our office will receive an email notification. Once registration has been approved, the credit card payment process will automatically activate. If you are registering more than one child for an Event, you will need to register and pay for each child individually.

To pay by check:

-Make the check payable to MSU Extension
-Make a Note indicating which Event the payment is for
-Include your phone number on the check
-Mail your check to our office or drop it off in person (*please call first:* 989-275-5043):

Please note that registration is not complete until all steps are completed.

States' 4-H International Exchange Programs 2023 INBOUND PROGRAMS

Host a delegate in your home this summer and give your family a global perspective!



Host a Japanese youth in Summer 2023 through States' 4-H International!

Invite an international youth into your home for three and a half weeks and share an American experience. Expand your family's cultural understanding, learn about new foods and customs, and possibly a new language all while sharing your own. Your children will build lifelong friendships and will gain new perspectives on their own country too!

Open your home to an exchange student and open your lives to the world!





HOSTING PERIOD: 3 1/2 weeks from late July to mid August

- You can host a youth aged 12-18 or an adult chaperone
- Youth have a range of English language abilities, so host families should be prepared to communicate imaginatively

HOST FAMILY REQUIREMENTS

- You must have a child of the same gender who is within 3 years of the hosted youth (children aged 9+ are eligible to host)
- Families without children of the appropriate age may host an adult chaperone
- No special activities need to be planned since these youth want to experience American culture, make new friends, and improve their English by staying with your family
- You don't need to be involved with 4-H to host
