




The purpose of a business plan

- Tell your story (pitch)
- Identify business needs
- Plan for the future
- Important for financing

A business plan is a written document outlining what you plan to do as a business and how you plan to do it, in a concise way.








Sections of a Business Plan


A typical business plan includes these main sections:


- 1. Cover Page

- 3. Executive Summary
- 4. Business Description
- 5. Operations
- 6. Marketing Plan
- 7. Management and Organization
- 8. Financial Plan
- 9. Appendix














Executive Summary

Goal: Quick overview of your business plan

- 2 to 3 pages
- Highlight the different sections of your plan
- Only the main details
- Write this section LAST




