To be eligible as an Eaton County delegate for the State 4-H Horse Show, you must:

1. Complete this Educational Activity Record as outlined. Signatures need to be legible; dates present; reports, outlines, photos attached as required; descriptions and other information requested filled in.
2. Participate in the previous year's Eaton County Fair horse classes. If you did not participate in the previous year's fair, you may be approved to attend the State 4-H Horse Show at the discretion of the Horse Development Committee (HDC) board and your club leader.
3. Be 13-19 years old on January 1, 2023.
4. This packet and any needed attachments are due to the MSU Extension office by Friday, July 1, 2023. Selected delegates will be contacted to fill out the paperwork needed to attend the State 4-H Horse Show.
5. Points will be considered from the prior year's Eaton County Fair if the number of delegates applying to the State 4-H Horse Show exceeds the county's allocated quota of delegates.
6. All chosen delegates will receive a \$30.00 scholarship to put towards the fees.
