This award is the National Leadership Award from the American Youth Foundation and award recipients receive a copy of I Dare You! by William H. Danforth and an invitation to participate in the National Leadership Conference.

Past winners are not eligible. Any 4-H leader or 4-H member may make nominations and members may self-nominate.

To nominate a member, complete the information requested below and summarize the member's overall leadership, character and personal development. The 4-H Awards Committee will make final selections. In the case of a close decision, preference may be given to the older members. The award will be presented at the 4-H Council Participation Celebration awards banquet.
