Swine 2019 “Tag In” Instructions

Once again, there will be no swine tag in at the fairgrounds.

The administrative or swine leaders will be responsible for picking up the ear tags and entry forms from the Extension Office and will be helping their club members to complete the forms and return them to the Extension Office before April 26, 2019. Please take no more tags than what are needed for each member. Ear taggers will be available upon request at the Extension Office. Hogs that have USDA tags can keep the USDA tags in the ear (do not have to retag), but must still fill out and return the form, hair samples, and photos.

Once again this year, tags will be registered with the state and therefore all unused tags **MUST** be returned to the Extension Office by April 26.

If a tag falls out or is lost after April 26, it must be replaced with a new registered tag. To obtain a new tag, contact Roger Harris or Clarence Humphrey. Replacement tags must also be registered with the state.

This year we are requiring each member to provide:

- Hair sample from each hog. (Bags will be provided at the Extension Office)
- Each member can tag in up to 5 hogs.
- A photo of each hog with the ear tag in ear.
- Each club must return all member forms, hair samples, and photos together.

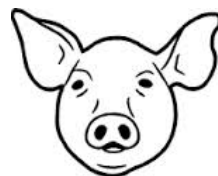
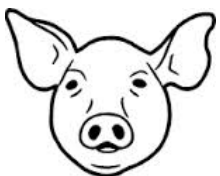
