

HUNTING AND WILDLIFE PROGRAM

Age Requirements:

Youths participating can be between 5 and 19 years old. The member's age is determined by his or her age on January 1 of the 4-H program year. Cloverbuds (youth ages 5 - 7) may participate in this shooting sports discipline only. Cloverbuds may not participate in any handling or live fire of bows or firearms nor any competitive events.

Meets:

Meets will be held at Kardel Hall and Bellevue Conservation Club. The youths will have the opportunity to learn types of outdoor and other cooking, outdoor preparedness, and wildlife biology (tracking, animal behavior, and animal characteristics). There is a \$10.00 fee to join the Eaton County 4-H Shooting Sports Club. Youth must be enrolled in 4-H Online with the medical consents completed prior to their first meeting and complete the participation agreement at the first meeting. Fair requirements are listed in the Fair Book.
