## When should you contact 4-H staff?

4-H volunteers (Gold or Silver level) should contact 4-H staff **immediately** regarding any of the following concerns:

- **%** Injury at a 4-H event
  - 4-H event means any event where you or a 4-H member is present in their 4-H capacity and may include: Club meetings, project meetings, field trips, club parties, club fundraisers, club community service projects, animal tagging as a club, fair participation (only during times when acting in 4-H capacity), state 4-H events, and more.
  - Any participant wanting to submit a claim to the Michigan 4-H supplemental accident insurance policy must contact 4-H staff and submit forms within 20 days of the date of injury (4-H staff will help with the forms and claim submission).
  - Make sure to fill out the MSU Injury and Property Damage Report Form:

- Property damage at a 4-H event
  - 4-H event means any event where you or a 4-H member is present in their 4-H capacity and may include: Club meetings, project meetings, field trips, club parties, club fundraisers, club community service projects, animal tagging as a club, fair participation (only during times when acting in 4-H capacity), state 4-H events, and more.

- Suspected, disclosed, or witnessed child abuse or neglect

- # Discrimination concerns, relationship violence and sexual misconduct, or Title IX violations
  - Reports should also be filed with the MSU Office of Institutional Equity: https://civilrights.msu.edu/file-a-report/index.html
- **Behavioral concerns or discipline issues with youth, parents, or volunteers** 
  - Volunteers do not have authority to remove someone from 4-H participation
