- Only female mosquitoes bite people.

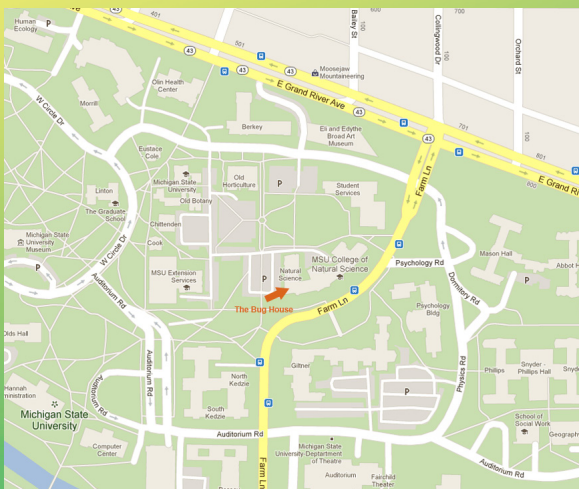
