Human Dimensions of Forest Carbon Management

This course is part of the Certificate in Forest Carbon Science, Policy, and Management.

- Analyze social dimensions associated with development and implementation of forest carbon projects and programs (e.g., REDD+, community, and private)
- Explore valuation of trees and forests by local landowners and communities as compared to the international community
- Undertake risk assessments and analyze safeguards
- Delve into the role of stakeholder engagement and collaborative processes in decision-making about forest resource priorities
- Interpret and leverage tools, methodologies, and participatory approaches used by practitioners in forest carbon projects and program development
