7. Western Horsemanship (Pattern Class) – Place Only 4-H Only
8. Tennessee Walker Saddle Seat Pleasure (Gaited) – Place Only 4-H Only

4-H Junior & Senior participants will judge all classes.

4-H Cloverbud participants will judge only classes 3-6. They will answer questions. They are not required to give reasons but are welcomed to. Cloverbuds will be able to sit and watch classes 1 & 2 where they will receive extra help & directions from their group leader or a designated coach/parent.
