Position Summary: Under direction of the horticulture staff, the seasonal gardener will work with a team of volunteers and staff to maintain display gardens, greenhouses, conservatories, irrigation and turf at Frederik Meijer Gardens & Sculpture Park. This position begins in April and continues through the end of August.

Essential Functions:

- Work with permanent horticulture staff to coordinate and carry out daily tasks.
- Assist with maintenance of plants in greenhouses, conservatories, and specialty gardens including but not limited to: watering, pruning, mulching, fertilizing, propagating, and weeding.
- Assist with the changing of seasonal exhibits, displays and container plantings.
- Ability to operate utility vehicles, power equipment and machinery.
- Supervise, train, and lead volunteers
- Work a rotation of weekends and holidays
- Assist guests
- Ability to carry out daily duties with limited supervision
- Other duties as assigned by supervisor

- Embrace and adhere to Meijer Gardens' mission, brand statement, operating model, policies, procedures, and guiding principles with a strong emphasis on professional behavior and the treatment of others with dignity and respect
