GENERAL RULES:

1. \$25 blanket fee per Horse/rider per show.
2. Twilight Youth Shows open to youth ages 8-19 years, rider age as of Jan. 1, 2023.
3. 4-H rules apply.
4. No Show clothes. Tack should be appropriate for class.
5. All riders must wear an ASTM/SEI helmet when riding Gymkhana and English.
6. Walk Trot (W/T) participants may only show in the designated W/T classes.
7. Walk Trot Gymkhana: if horse break into a lope for 3 consecutive strides they are disqualified from the event.
8. All participants must clean up after their horses. All manure must be put in appropriate locations. Stalls must be cleaned if used. Horses may be tied to trailers. All manure must be put in appropriate container. Please leave area around trailers clean and fill any divots.
9. As per Michigan law all horses must have a current copy of a negative Coggins test (within 12 months).
10. The show committee reserves the right to combine/spilt/revise classes.
