## GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION:

- 1. 4-H rules apply. Rider age as of January 1, 2024. Horse age as of December 31, 2024.
- 2. All riders 19 & under must wear an ASTM/SEI helmet when riding Gymkhana & English. Helmets optional in all other classes.
- 3. Walk Trot (W/T) participants may only show in the designated W/T classes and Halter classes.

Walk Trot 20+

- 4. W/T Gymkhana: if horse breaks into a lope for 3 consecutive strides they are disqualified from the event.
- 5. W/T 20+ show clothes are optional. Open to parents, grooms, and others.
- 6. Ranch Riding and Pleasure: Bands/braids and show tack allowed, but natural look is encouraged.
- 7. Pee Wee or Lead line classes are available for youth 7 & under. Lead Line participants can enter Pee Wee Showmanship but may not participate in the Pee Wee Walk or Walk Trot classes.
- 8. Stallions must be shown by an adult 18 years or older.
- 9. The show committee reserves the right to combine/split classes.
- 10. The show committee reserves the right to request exhibitors or horse's proof of age, if there is a dispute.
- 11. As per Michigan law all horses must have a current copy of a negative Coggins test (within 12 months).

### **HIGH POINT RULES:**

- 1. 1 horse, 1 rider combination. Must identify high point section on entry form. No fee required to enter.
- 2. 1 high point & 1 reserve high point awarded in each division.
- 3. Performance points will be calculated from the highest points within one like class in Halter, Showmanship, English Pleasure, English Equitation or Dressage Seat Equitation, Western Pleasure, Western Horsemanship and Trail.
- 4. Gymkhana points will be calculated from all 6 gymkhana classes.
- 5. Classes not eligible for High Point: PEP, Ranch, Jr horse and Pee Wee classes.
- 6. In the event of a tie breaker, the rider with the most 1<sup>st</sup> places wins and if still tied the judge will break the tie with a question.

### TEAM COMPETITION RULES:

- 1. Teams of up to 4 riders. \$10 fee per exhibitor. Top 3 teams awarded prizes.
- 2. 1 horse, 1 rider combination.
- 3. Halter, Showmanship, Dressage Seat Equitation/ English Equitation, English Pleasure, Western Horsemanship, Western Pleasure, Ranch Riding, Ranch Horse Pleasure and Trail.
