What is the WFPMIYI? The World Food Prize Michigan Youth Institute is a one-day event that provides middle and high school students with the opportunity to share their ideas on how we can solve critical global challenges. When and where: The World Food Prize Michigan Youth Institute will be held Thursday, May 11, 2023, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. (Eastern Time Zone). Participants have the option of joining the World Food Prize Michigan Youth Institute in person on the campus of MSU in East Lansing, MI or by participating virtually using Zoom. New this year is an optional Networking Breakfast scheduled from 7:30 – 8:45 a.m. This will be a chance to meet some of the experts, MSU Extension staff, and other students informally before the day officially begins at 9 a.m. If you would like to attend the Networking Breakfast, select this option when you register.

**Who:** Students who are in grades 7 through 12 during the 2022-2023 school year are eligible to register by submitting a three-to-five-page paper that is written using our <u>Michigan Youth Institute Global Challenge Guide</u>. Teachers and Adult Mentors are also welcome to attend the event along with their students.

**Cost:** There is no registration fee for students or teachers/mentors to participate in the Institute thanks to the generous support of the Michigan 4-H Foundation, the World Food Prize Foundation, the MSU College of Agriculture and Natural Resources, MSU International Studies and Programs, MSU Extension, Michigan 4-H, and Michigan FFA. Lunch is provided for those attending the program in-person on the campus of MSU.

# Quiet Adventures Symposium - March 4th: 9am-5:30pm MSU Pavilion, 4301 Farm Ln

Lead environmental and outdoor education activities for youth attending the **Quiet Adventures Symposium**: An annual event featuring seminars and presentations by noted outdoor authors, researchers, and conservationists. The symposium is hosted by the Quiet Water Society, whose mission is to promote non-motorized (quiet) outdoor recreation.

- Sensory Table geared towards very young kids, consisting of rice, cornmeal, etc. with measuring tools, toys, etc. that they can play with.
- Trash to Treasures use a variety of "trash" items to create puppets (or other projects). The focus would be on littering, trash, & recycling.
- Fashion a Michigan Fish Youth would create (draw) fish incorporating characteristics from adaptation cards that they select. The adaptation cards would include things such as coloration/camouflage, body shape/form, mouth type.
- Build a Bug Like the fish activity, youth would create their own bugs, using various craft supplies to represent adaptations.
- Foil Boats design and build a boat with aluminum foil., then test its buoyancy by putting it in water and placing pennies on it until it sinks.
- Bird Feeders Pinecone feeders and feeders made from plastic bottles.





## **World Food Prize Michigan Youth Institute** registrations due March 15!

As millions across the globe deal with food insecurity, the World Food Prize Michigan Youth Institute (WFP MIYI) offers young people an opportunity to be part of the solution. Held May 11 in East Lansing, or by participating from anywhere else using Zoom video/web conference technology, the event seeks to inspire and prepare the next generation of global leaders to end world hunger.

Attendees will have the opportunity to share their ideas related to global food security with experts and other Michigan youth while learning how university faculty and staff members, researchers and students are working to address world hunger.

To participate, youth should be in grades 7-12 and register by the March 15 deadline. As part of the registration process, youth are required to prepare a two- to five-page research paper about a developing country and one of 20 key factors that affect food security. At the event, youth present and discuss their papers with other attendees and research and industry experts. They also participate in interactive activities related to global food challenges and engage with area experts to discuss solutions to global hunger and poverty.

The top performing students at the WFP MIYI will be selected to attend the World Food Prize Global Youth Institute in Des Moines, Iowa, in October. For more information, visit https://www.canr.msu.edu/wfpmiyi/. Registrations and papers are due March 15.
